direct quote	Using exact words from a source in quotation marks
annotated bibliography	A list of sources with summary and evaluation of each
signal phrase	Words that introduce a quote or paraphrase
academic integrity	Honest and ethical behavior in academic work
intellectual property	Creative work owned by its creator
